	8:00-8:30	Breakfast, Cheers, Advisor check-ins	CAFETERIA
A	8:35-9:25	Academic Class – <i>Literature</i> (<i>The other Wes Moore, A Raisin in the Sun, Farewell to Manzanar, other selected readings</i>)	CLASSROOMS <i>Each academic class is small – about 8-10 students.</i>
B	9:30-10:20	Academic Class – <i>Math</i> (Pre-Algebra, Algebra or Geometry)	CLASSROOMS <i>Breakthrough operates on a ‘waterfall’ schedule, so the order of A, B, C, and D blocks shifts each week.</i>
	10:20-10:30	SNACK	OUTSIDE or CAFETERIA <i>Food is provided by BTM.</i>
C	10:35-11:25	Academic Class – <i>Science</i> (Topics in Biology, Chemistry, and Physics)	CLASSROOMS
D	11:30-12:20	Academic Class – <i>Writing</i> (Expository, Descriptive, Persuasive, and Narrative Writing Styles)	CLASSROOMS
	12:25-12:55	LUNCH AND RECESS	CAFETERIA & OUTSIDE <i>Food is provided by BTM.</i>
	1:00-1:30	COMMUNITY BLOCK or ASSEMBLY <i>This is time spent together as a whole community – it could be a talent show, a competition, or small group activities.</i>	CAFETERIA or AUDITORIUM
	1:35-2:15	EXTRACURRICULAR <i>Students get to pick 2 extracurricular courses for the summer based on a menu of offerings that our teachers create. Each course lasts two weeks.</i>	
	2:20-2:50	STUDY, TUTORING AND ENRICHMENT <i>This is a time for students to get a head start on HW, ask follow up questions from their teachers, etc.</i>	TEAM ROOMS
	2:55 – 3:15	ADVISORY <i>Each student is assigned to an advisor. Each advisory has 3-5 students, and the advisor (a teacher) checks in with students on their progress, HW, and just generally how the students are doing/feeling at BTM.</i>	CLASSROOMS
